Public Notice

Southeastern Indiana Rural Telephone Cooperative, Inc. ("SIRTC") provides voice telephony service throughout its cooperative designated serving area, including minutes of use for local service provided at no additional charge; access to emergency services provided by local government or other public safety organizations, such as 911 and enhanced 911, to the extent the local government in SIRTC's service area has implemented 911 or enhanced 911 systems; and toll limitation for qualifying low-income consumers. Basic services monthly rates: (\$17.45)* single party residential line; (\$15.25-\$18.60)* multi and single party business lines; (\$6.50-\$9.20) single and multi-party federal subscriber line charge. *The rates do not include charges for long distance, operator services, directory assistance, 911 emergency services, or other taxes, fees and surcharges. Discounts are available to low-income customers who qualify for Lifeline, a government assistance program that is non-transferable and limited to one discount per household. Lifeline Assistance

Lifeline is a federal program that helps eligible consumers afford local telephone or broadband internet service. SEI Communications participates in the Lifeline Assistance Program to increase the availability of telecommunications services to all consumers in its serving areas.

You are eligible if someone in your household participates in one of the following programs:

- Household income at or below 135% of the federal poverty guidelines (see chart to the right)*
- Federal Veterans Pension
- Federal Public Housing Assistance or Section 8
- Medicaid
- Food Stamps
- Supplemental Security Income (SSI) Not to be confused with Social Security Income
